30th Macao International Fireworks Display Contest

During the period of this popular event, the Macao Government Tourism Office also hosts a much-anticipated photo contest, student drawing contest and trophy design contest, which attract a number of talented and creative participants. In order to attract more people to take part in this event, the Macao Government Tourism Office has set up a song composition contest in the "29th Macao International Fireworks Display Contest" in 2018.
